

Abbott World Marathon Majors

What's Abbott World Marathon Majors?

The Abbott World Marathon Majors (AbbottWMM) are a grand slam of marathons, made up of the seven most famous major marathons in the world (the Tokyo, Boston, London, Sydney, Berlin, Chicago, and New



York City marathons). From this year's series, the Sydney Marathon is also being added to the AbbottWMM, making it one of the world's most famous marathon series. It was launched in 2006 to further the development of marathons, foster awareness among competitors, and promote greater interest in elite races among running fans (Tokyo has been a member of the AbbottWMM since the 2013 marathon). The AbbottWMM series is the world's largest marathon series. It converts results from the above seven marathons, Olympic/Paralympic marathons, and World Athletics Championships/World Para Athletics Championships marathons into points, and runners compete for the highest point scores. The five athletes with the highest total scores at the end of the year-long series cycle receive monetary prizes. (both marathon and wheelchair marathon winners in the men's and women's categories win 50,000 dollars).

On the day of the Tokyo Marathon 2025, the event will be enlivened by dance, music, and traditional performing arts under the theme of "CHEER" from all 20 venues including along the course!!





Marunouchi Naka-dori Ave. Underpass Guide


Note: Some routes will only be available on the day of the marathon. Please follow the instructions of site staff.
















B1F ● BEAMS (1F) Marunouchi Building

Some movement restrictions will be placed for Hibiya-dori Ave., Marunouchi Naka-dori Ave., and Gyoko-dori Ave. in the finish area. Only runners and staff members will be allowed in these areas. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation.
